

SWIMMING POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS – updated May 2018

1. Children 9 and under must have a parent or baby-sitter who is 13 or older with them in the pool area.
2. Children 10 to 12, and having passed their swimming test, may come to the pool without a baby-sitter. However, their parent must be present on the Country Club property. (Swimming test is to swim unaided without touching the side from the shallow end to the deep end.)
3. Children 13 and over may come to pool unsupervised and their parents do not have to be on the Country Club Property.
4. Lifeguards cannot be baby-sitters. Children must be able to swim to the satisfaction of the lifeguards before being allowed in the deep end of the pool.
5. No glass containers are allowed anywhere in the pool area. (In accordance with Kentucky Public Swimming Pool Regulation – 401 KAR 6:030.)
6. The baby pool is designated exclusively for children under the age of 6.
7. Babies must wear swimmer diapers.
8. Running in the pool area is considered a very serious offense.
9. Playing around, on or near the diving board and/or slide is strictly forbidden. Only one person on the slide at a time and only one person on the diving board at a time.
10. No diving or turning flips from the side of the pool.
11. Use ladders to get in and out of the pool.
12. No sun bathing floats in the pool.
13. When a person is observed breaking any of the rules, they will be warned once. On the second infraction, they will be banned from the pool for the remainder of that day or for as long as a week. This can be done at the lifeguards' discretion. People who continually break pool rules could possibly be banned for the summer by HCC management.
14. All swimmers must register each day with lifeguard. The member is responsible for registering their guest. There is a \$5.00 guest fee, unless the guest is a house guest of a member, in which case there is a \$25.00 per week fee for a house guest family. Guests are allowed to visit the pool a maximum of 5 times during any swimming season. Grandchildren 12 and under of members are allowed to visit the pool a maximum of 10 times per season. Members must accompany their guests at all times in the pool area.
15. No outside food or drink is allowed.
16. People in bathing suits are not allowed in the clubhouse at any time.
17. All water guns, roller-blades, bikes, roller-skates, etc. are not allowed at any time inside the pool area, nor on the Country club Golf Course.
18. 17 and older can swim before/after normal hours of operation. The pool closes when the 19th hole closes. Normal hours of operation with a lifeguard are Monday – Friday 10-5pm, Saturday 11am-5pm, Sunday 12-5pm. No person can swim alone. Parents (adults) must accompany children (under 17).
